Chris Snyder is the director of coaching for the United States Olympic Committee. In his current role, Snyder and the coaching department support the USOC sport performance department by working in coach education, coaching development and coach recognition for all Olympic and Pan-American sports, as well as working as an advisor for U.S. Paralympic sport on coaching. The coaching department has created various resources that aid the National Governing Bodies, from a mobile application system for sharing coaching resources, to a long-term athlete development system called the American Development Model (ADM). The coaching department also operates several high performance coaching programs to grow the level of quality coaching by national team level coaches that lead Team USA into the Olympic, Paralympic and Pan-American Games.

Previously, Snyder served as the manager of coaching education and training for U.S. Lacrosse in Baltimore. He has also coached competitive sports for over 15 years at the collegiate, high school and competitive club levels.
