CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER, USA ARCHERY

Denise Parker was hired as chief executive officer of USA Archery in 2008. A graduate of Westminster College in Salt Lake City, Denise earned her B.S. degree in marketing. She earned her M.B.A. from the University of Utah. Denise has also enjoyed a successful Olympic career as an athlete. She took home a team bronze medal as the youngest member of the U.S. Olympic Archery Team at the 1988 Seoul Games. Denise also competed in the 1992 and 2000 Olympic Games. At age 13, she was the youngest archer ever to win a gold medal at the Pan American Games. Denise currently serves on the board of directors for the United States Olympic Endowment and the advisory board of directors for the Utah Sports Commission. She is vice chair of the National Governing Body Council and chair of World Archery's Gender Equity and Good Governance Committees.
